

EGG BASKET JAR

Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Wide Mouth Quart Jar

1 yd. 18 Gauge Clear Green Wire*

1 yd. 7/8" Wide Orange Polka Dot Ribbon

Yellow Easter Grass

13 Small Plastic Eggs, Assorted Colors

One 1 1/2" Tall White Bunny (sitting)

2" x 4" Piece Small Dots Green Scrapbook Paper*

*We used Fun Wire from AMACO® and Scrapbooking Paper from Making Memories®.

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, ruler and paper punch.

Fun Project Idea:

For Easter or spring fun, place candy or jelly beans into the jar or in the eggs for a colorful and tasty treat. For other seasons of the year, use colored raffia or paper shreds and fill with seasonal items.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Assembling Jar: Put Easter grass into jar until two-thirds full. Arrange bunny and ten eggs on top of grass. Starting at one side of jar, wrap wire around neck of jar. Twist end around wire. To form handle, bring wire up over top of jar and twist wire end around wire on neckband on opposite side of jar. Bend and shape wire handle as desired.

Step 3, Finishing Touches: From ribbon, cut 12" length and tie into a knot around handle. Wrap remaining ribbon around lower part of jar and tie into a knot on front. Trim ribbon ends. For gift card, fold scrapbook paper in half and punch hole at upper left hand corner. Write message on gift card and slide card onto one ribbon end at handle. Place remaining eggs at base of jar.
