Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® or Kerr® Wide
Mouth Quart Jar

1 Ball or Kerr Wide
Mouth Band

1 (4-ounce) Can Non-
Toxic Yellow Craft Spray
Paint

1 (6- x 6-inch) Piece
Orange Felt

10 Yellow Dyed Craft
Feathers

2 (20mm) Wiggle Eyes

Green Artificial Grass

Jelly Beans or Other
Candy

**Additional craft supplies
to have on hand:** Scissors,
pencil, paper towels, house-
hold or craft glue, rubber
gloves, cardboard box and
newspaper.

Fun Project Idea

When all of your candy is gone and your sweet tooth satisfied, fill your Sweet Peep with fresh-cut flowers for the sunniest centerpiece.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions for Sweet Peep Jar before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Assembling Sweet Peep Base: Lay cardboard box on its side over newspaper in a well-ventilated area. Place jar and band separately inside box. Put on rubber gloves. Spray yellow paint onto jar and band. Allow to dry; repeat if necessary for an even coating. Adjust band onto jar.

Glue wiggle eyes to side of jar, about 4 inches down from the top. Print provided “beak” and “feet” template. Trace beak and feet templates onto orange felt, cut out. To form beak, fold at line and glue together in spots marked; let dry. Place drops of glue on back of beak and glue to jar below wiggle eyes. Cut feet out and glue to bottom of jar so feet peek out. Glue 4 feathers to inside of band to create peep’s “hair.” Glue 3 feathers on each side to create wings.

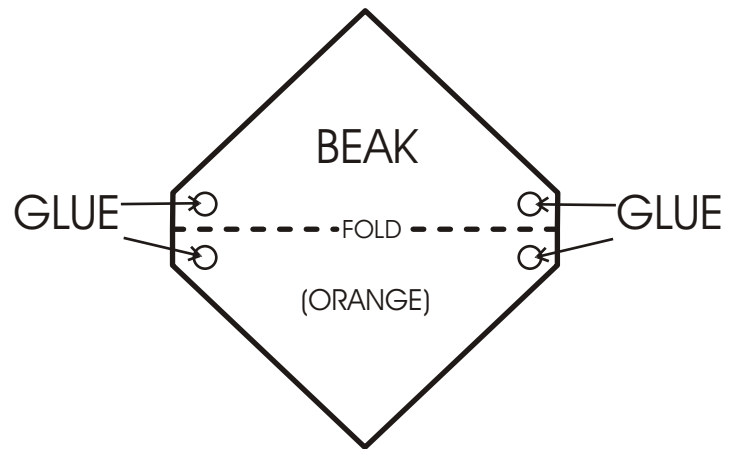
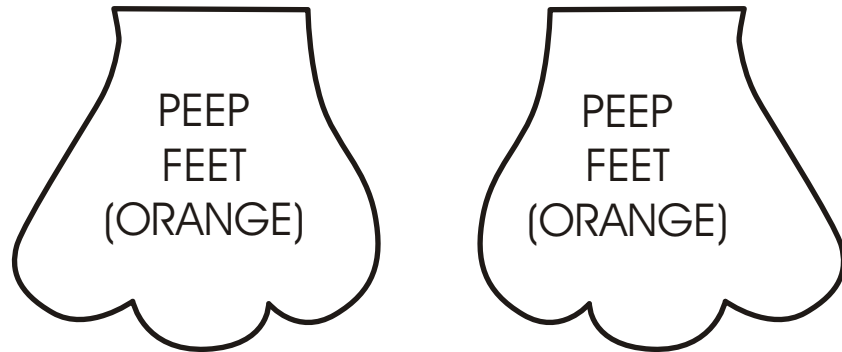
Important note: If using a hot glue gun, use only according to manufacturer’s instructions and in a safe, well-ventilated location.

Step 3, Finishing Touches: Fill Sweet Peep with artificial grass. Place candy on top of grass.
